POST-SECONDARY PATHWAYS RESEARCH PROJECT

WHAT YOU'RE GOING TO DO:

After conducting a number of personality and skills tests, you should have a fairly clear picture of what career options are best suited for you. Based on your findings, you will now complete a post-secondary pathways research activity that will help you determine the best direction to choose to help you reach your ultimate career goal following completion of high school.

RESEARCH PROCESS:

- 1. Complete the Secondary School Requirements and Personal Education Plan (grade 9 and 10 only) handouts in class. These will provide you with a clearer understanding of what credits and requirements you must satisfy in order to graduate high school.
- 2. Based on class discussions and career research completed above, determine which are the most suitable post-secondary options to pursue your career. Choose TWO of the following pathways to explore further: Apprenticeships, College or University.
- 3. Using the research handouts provided in class, complete the necessary investigation of your TWO chosen pathways. Make sure to keep accurate notes during this stage.
- **4.** After completing step #3, consult with your teacher to decide which postsecondary option is best for you (including selection of specific institution/program). Your instructor will provide a final research handout to help you gather the required program information.

After conducting the necessary research, you will prepare a detailed slideshow (Prezi, Powerpoint or Keynote) that you will present to the class.
