PRESENTATION OUTLINE

After completing your post-secondary pathway/career research, you will produce a well-organized, professional quality presentation that you will deliver to the class. For this assignment, you should plan to use PREZI as you can access this free application online from home or school and it is compatible with both PC and MAC computer platforms. You will need to download your final Prezi for use in class (instructions to follow).

PRESENTATION CONTENT/ORDER:

Visit the course website to view a sample LEVEL 4 presentation (in Powerpoint). Your Presentation will contain similar information organized in the same basic order. Use the list below as a guide for required material in your presentation and the order it should appear.

CAREER OVERVIEW:	
	TITLE/INTRO SLIDE – includes your name, job/career title and NOC# (from career sites visited earlier in course)
	CAREER DESCRIPTION – detailed information about the career you've chosen (as found on career sites you used for your research)
	SPECIFIC DUTIES – provide thorough information about the main responsibilities of your career
	WORKING CONDITIONS - explain the type of day-to-day conditions/activities that people working in your chosen career can expect
	EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS – thorough list of specific requirements to enter your chosen career (academic, certification/licensing, experience, union/organization memberships, etc.)
	RELATED CAREERS – give a list of other careers connected to your chosen career in some way
EDUCATION/TRAINING PATH:	
	HIGH SCHOOL PATH – provide a breakdown of required and/or recommended courses you need to take (from grade 9 to 12) in order to qualify for a your specific post-secondary path (what you need to get into a specific program)
	POST-SECONDARY OPTIONS – list 3-4 institutions that offer programs to help you get into your chosen career (include name of school/institution, location, name of program if available)
	 YOUR SCHOOL/INSITUTION CHOICE – identify the specific school YOU would attend on your path to your chosen career; list the following important information (may need a few "slides"): School name, location, specific program name, program options (ex. co-op vs. regular classes), minimum grades to get into program, high school pre-requisite courses for program Institution/Program Information – tuition costs, school/incidental fees, residence fees, meal plans for students (and estimated costs), residence availability/guarantees for first year students, estimated book/supply costs (if available)
CAREER PATH:	
	CAREER PATH - step-by-step description of typical progression in your chosen career (promotions, growth, etc.)
	EARNINGS – give details about projected salaries in your chosen field (include range from low to high if possible)
	EMPLOYERS/OUTLOOK – list potential employers and projected outlook (job openings vs. people entering that field) for your chosen career
	RESOURCES – final "slide" should have list of websites used to complete research
